- Paintings (must be at least 18" tall and ready to hang)
- Drawings (must be at least 14" tall and ready to display)
- Photography (must be at least 18" tall and ready to hang)
- Miniatures (must be under 3" tall)
- Shell Gorgets (at least 4" in diameter)
- Clothing
- Functional Art (bow and arrow, weaponry, shields, musical instruments)
- Jewelry (necklace, ring, earrings, hair ornaments, pins, bolo, bracelet, cuffs)
- Open (items without a listed category)

*PAIRS OF ITEMS EX. BALL STICKS, EARRINGS, FOOTWEAR, ETC. COUNT AS 1 ITEM. IF YOU ONLY HAVE ONE OF SOMETHING CONSIDERED A PAIR YOUR ENTRY IS NOT COMPLETE AND WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.

Guidelines for entry:

- Must be EBCI enrolled (must present enrollment card)
- Must be 16-21 years old at the time of art entry for youth categories and
 22+ years old for adult categories (ID required)
- Must fill out a W9 form (will need SS# and current mailing address)
- Only one entry per category, per person allowed.
- The Open category is only for items that do not have a designated category. Entries that have a category will not be permitted in the Open category.
- All entries must incorporate the theme "Legendary Creatures" and must relate to Cherokee history and/or culture.
- All entries must have a completed entry form filled out.
- All entries must be displayed in the art show on November 4, 2023.
- Kananesgi will not sell artwork in the show this year.
- Must drop off and pick up items at designated times.
- If you do not pick up before the last designated time your items will be donated to the Kananesgi Art Market event for fundraising.
- Entries must have been made after January 1, 2023.
- Do not copy or use someone else's work or intellectual property. If you do, you will be disqualified.
- You must bring your items yourself. Someone else is not allowed to bring your items.
- All entries must be safe to handle.
 Fill out any special handling instructions on the entry theme form.
- Participation in the event is at your own risk.
- Early entries may be considered on an individual basis and are subject to committee approval.
- Judges do not have to select a winner for each place in each category.
- Event organizers reserve the right to change any categories or prize money amounts and deny any entry with no appeal process.
